A timeline from referral to treatment

1

GP Referral

A referral is sent from the GP or specialist to the Women's.
This includes results of required tests and investigations.

3

Patient is added to the waitlist

The accepted referral is added to the waitlist - either at the Women's or their local health service.

5

Follow-up Appointments

Additional appointments may be required, depending on an individual patient's needs. 7


Nurse education

The patient attends an education session about the treatment plan and learns about medication management.

9

Fertility treatment commences

Fertility treatment usually commences 1-3 months after all the steps leading up to a plan is complete.

Referral review

The referral is processed and triaged by the Women's. Both the patient and GP are notified on next steps via a letter.

4

First appointment

A letter is sent to the patient when an appointment has been scheduled at the Women's or their local health service.

6

Treatment plan is established

The patient is provided with a fertility treatment plan.

8

Counselling

The patient is required to attend counselling sessions, tailored to their treatment plan.
